



## Mogden Sewage Treatment Works: 2014 updates



### **3 December 2014 - Notification of critical maintenance**

We will be carrying out critical maintenance on Wednesday 3 December 2014 which could potentially cause odour.

Pasteurisation stream number nine will be undergoing maintenance from contractors Black and Veatch.

This work requires engineers to enter the tank. To ensure the atmosphere is safe and compliant with health and safety regulations the stream will be drained, washed and cleaned; we will then carry out forced air ventilation, forcing air through the system.

Although we do not expect any odour from this operation, we are placing a notification as a precautionary measure

### **4 July 2014 - Drain down of primary tank**

We have identified that a pump on one of our open circular Primary Settlement Tanks on the west side of the works is faulty.

In order to fix this we need to drain down the tank tomorrow (Tuesday 1 July). This process could cause odour, which may be noticed from your property.

We are sorry for any odour noticed during this essential work, and would like to assure you that we will complete the job as quickly as possible.

### **18 March 2014 - Drain down of primary tank**

We need to drain down one of our circular Primary Settlement Tanks at Mogden, in order to carry out routine planned maintenance.

This will begin tomorrow morning (Wednesday 19 March) and will take several hours, after which the tank will be cleaned.

### **23 January 2014 - Drain down of primary tank**

We are experiencing an intermittent electrical fault with the scraper bridge, on one of our circular Primary Settlement Tanks at Mogden.

In order to fix it we need to drain the tank, which we will start tomorrow morning.
